We have a mixed membership of families, couples and singles who enjoy each other's company, and if you wish there are more peaceful spots in this lovely place, called "The Orchard". Work continues year on year to improve the facilities for our members.

The site is a beautiful mix of lawns, trees and flower beds, and if you feel like a bit more activity then the Boules court is a few steps away from our Swimming Pool.



The BBQ is lit some evenings during the summer when members bring their own food to the flame and chat until the stars come out, or pop to the pavilion where we have a log burning fire and relaxing chairs for cold evenings and a well equipped kitchen that turns out fantastic food for the varied social calendar of events held throughout the year.



The club is busiest during the Summer, welcoming British and other naturists for day visits and short holidays, as long as they have INF/BN or affiliated club membership.

All types of camping can be accommodated for short stays. Electric hook-ups are available on a first come first served basis. Unfortunately, there is no holiday accommodation to rent, as the club is small in size. The maximum length of any camping vehicle we can accept is 8m, and there are only a few pitches that can accept anything over 6m. Visitors are asked to contact the Secretary in advance to check space is available. The local village, with a shop, butcher, fish & chip and Chinese take-away, 2 public houses, is 1.5miles away.



Our facilities include a Club House, with showers and toilets; open-air pool, children's play area, sauna, sun lawns, kitchen and a shop that sells sweets, ice creams and drinks. We are wheelchair friendly and have disabled facilities.
