Cambridge Outdoor Club was founded in 1967 and is reputed to be one of the prettiest naturist clubs in the county. The site has been developed over the years into "Our Little Piece of Eden".

The Club is owned by its members and we work hard throughout the year to maintain its grounds and improve the facilities.

We have a mixed membership of families, couples and singles who enjoy the club throughout the year and you can always find a peaceful spot to chill out completely.

The club is busiest during the summer welcoming British and other naturists for day visits and short holidays as long as they have INF/BN or affiliated membership.

The site is a beautiful mix of lawns, trees and flower beds, and if you feel like a bit more activity the Boules court is a few steps away from our Swimming Pool.

We have mostly electric hook-ups and can accommodate caravans, motorhomes and tents. All pitches are available on a first come first served basis.

There is no holiday accommodation to rent.

Our Clubhouse and Kitchen are open for use by all members and visitors and has fridges and freezers available along with a large cooker, small cooker and microwave where you can make tea and coffee and prepare meals. An outside washing up area is set behind the clubhouse and is fully covered in case of wet weather.



There are comfortable chairs and a log burning fire for those evenings when its a bit cooler. We have a small shop with sweets, ice cream, drinks and a few essentials. Within the main clubhouse there is access to our Sauna and separate shower.



A regular Sauna evening is held monthly but it can be used at anytime for a fee. A toilet block and showers are set at one end of the building.

Next to our clubhouse is our multi-function Sun Room with removable canvas doors and some comfortable chairs. Being south facing even cooler days can be spent in the warm sunshine where you can relax and take it easy, do a bit of bird watching as the site is visited by many British species or borrow a book from our clubhouse library.



Throughout the Summer months members and visitors alike sometimes come together for their evening meals in the Sun Room.

If you enjoy sunbathing or swimming naked or just soaking up the sun with no clothes on and think you might like to experience naturism then contact our Membership Secretary and arrange visit and maybe become a member.



Set in rural Cambridgeshire near the borders of both Norfolk and Suffolk we are well situated for visits to the university city of Cambridge with its amazing colleges, just 11 miles away or just 9 miles to Ely where you can visit the

beautiful cathedral known as the "Ship of the Fens". Both hold large markets

on Saturdays and have all the well-known High Street shops and supermarkets.

If a visit to the seaside is your want then Sunny Hunny (Hunstanton) is just an hour away where you can have fish and chips in the



sunshine, wander along the

beach and take in the magnificent red and white cliffs or take in the thrills of the funfair.

The local amenities are in Haddenham

village just 1.5 miles away where you have passed through to get to Cambridge Outdoor Club. You will find most of what you need with a grocery shop, pharmacy, fish and chips and Chinese takeaway, Butchers. The Three Kings public house sells good food.

Haddenham also has a Gallery selling local arts and crafts and holds a Steam Rally every September that is well known for miles around. Just up The Borough from Cambridge Outdoor Club there is also Artes Mundi selling carefully chosen Fair Trade gifts.



In nearby Wilburton you can also find local shops a post office, public house and a garden centre selling plants and gifts.
